New students registering for <u>kindergarten</u> must reach the age of **five (5)** on or before December 31, 2020. Current Pre-K students are already registered in kindergarten. Students new to CES must have proper forms completed as soon as possible. *There is a link to the necessary forms below.* 

The <u>pre-kindergarten</u> program is designed to provide readiness skills to children who will be entering kindergarten the following year as well as students with special education needs. **CES** will be conducting online screenings starting June 8<sup>th</sup>. Eligible children must be **three years** of age by August 31 and cannot turn 5 before January 1. There is a link to the pre-registration forms below. After CES receives these forms, parents will receive an email with online screening information.

Items *necessary* to finalize registration for both <u>Kindergarten</u> and <u>Pre-K</u>:

- 1. Birth Certificate
- 2. Immunization records
- 3. Copy of the last physical examination (not older than a year)
- 4. Health Insurance Card
- 5. Parent/Legal Guardian Photo ID & legal guardianship document (if applicable)
- 6. Proof of Chaplin residency (provide one of the following):
  - Lease, Gas Bill, or Electricity Bill

**PRE-K Only**: Proof of Income (provide one of the following):

Pay Stubs, State Budget Sheet, Unemployment, SSI or Social Security

**Pre-K** or **Kindergarten** 

The selection of **Pre-K** children is made by program staff and administrators based upon previously determined criteria and an online, play-based developmental screen. Priority is given to: <u>first-students</u> who will be four years of age prior to January 1; <u>second-Students</u> who have an identified special need, and third-three year olds.

**Pre-K Only:** The Ages to Stages Questionnaire is due by June 26th.

Applicants will be notified of their acceptance into the program by July 3rd.
